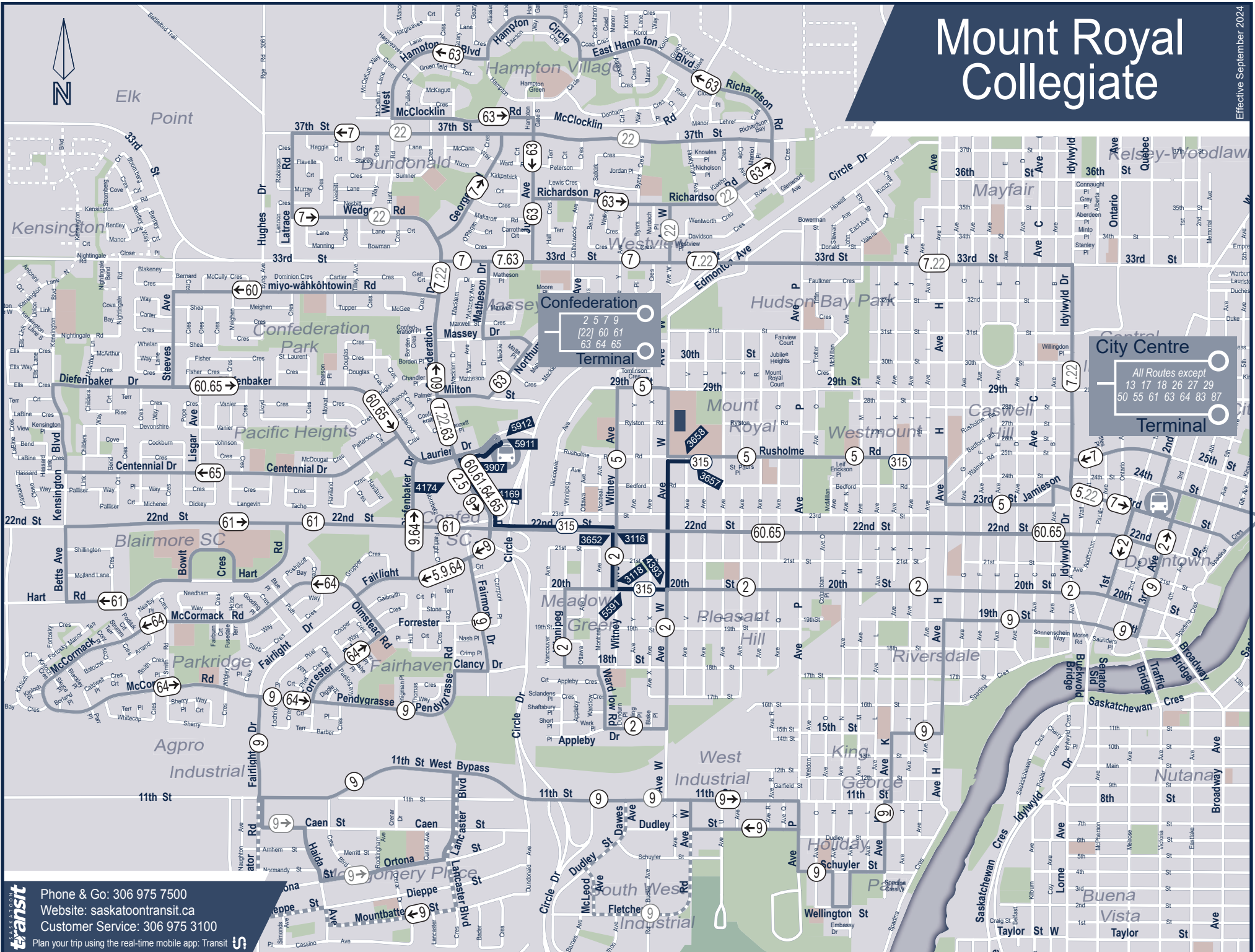

A valid Saskatoon High School student card is required when using a High School bus pass or paying the High School fare rate. Please show your student card along with your pass when boarding.



Transit passes are sold in the school office as well as various locations throughout the city. Please visit Saskatoontransit.ca for specific locations.

There is a \$5 fee for all new cards. GoPass cards can be registered for free at the Customer Service office (226 12th Street East). Card(s) must be presented at the time of registration.

Lost/Stolen Cards

If a card is lost/stolen, a replacement card can be issued. Please provide one piece of identification to match the name the card is registered to. There will be a \$5 new card activation fee. Over the phone reports of lost/stolen cards will not be accepted as identification is required.

All school special routes are subject to change during the school year.

Remember to be at your stop 5 minutes before the bus is due to arrive. Plan your route online at Saskatoontransit.ca or on your mobile device with the real-time Google Maps  or Transit App .
