

22nd Street Route Changes: Frequently Asked Questions

Why is Saskatoon Transit making changes to the routes along 22nd Street?

Both current and potential riders have expressed a desire to access more frequent buses during peak hours, so to improve service and better serve our citizens, frequency of buses along 22nd Street will increase.

What does increased frequency look like?

Routes along 22nd Street will offer 7.5 minute frequencies during peak periods (7 a.m. – 9 a.m. & approximately 3 p.m. – 6 p.m.) and 10 minute frequencies during the remainder of the weekday, with 30 minute frequencies during evenings, weekends, and statutory holidays.

When do the route changes for 22nd Street take effect?

These changes take effect July 2, 2017.

What routes are being changed?

Routes 10, 22, 23, 28, 40, 60 and 65.

Are there new routes?

Yes. New route numbers for 22nd Street service include Route 61, 62 and 63

Are any routes being discontinued?

Route 23 Hampton Village/Blairmore will be discontinued as of July 2, 2017. Customers can now use Route 61 Blairmore or Route 63 Hampton Village.

Are routes on both sides of the city being affected?

Routes 10, 22, 60 and 65 on the west side of the city are being updated.

Routes 28 and 40 on the east side of the city are being updated.

Where can I find more information?

Saskatoon Transit is holding a Come and Go Information Session on Thursday, June 22 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at Confederation Mall near the food court to discuss the increased frequency along 22nd Street.

High Frequency Service on 22nd Street (Routes 60, 61, 62, 63 and 65)

- 7 ½ minute high frequency service on 22nd Street, Monday to Friday, peak periods only
- Peak periods – approximately 7 a.m. – 9 a.m. & approximately 3 p.m. – 6 p.m.

Route 10 Pleasant Hill

- Frequency: 30 minutes daytime / Saturday: 30 minutes 11 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- Route 10 will travel through Meadowgreen following the same route as the Route 2
- Saturday and Sunday service remains the same

Route 22 City Centre AM

- Frequency: peak hours only, 30 minutes directional route from Confederation Mall and Downtown Terminal
- Leaves Confederation Mall Terminal :08 & :38
- Leaves Downtown Terminal :07 & :37 to Place Riel
- Travel to Place Riel will pick up and drop off passengers via 3rd Avenue and 25th Street

Route 22 Confederation PM

- Frequency: peak hours only, 30 minutes directional route from Downtown Terminal to Confederation Mall
- Leaves Downtown Terminal: :01 & :31 to Confederation Mall Terminal
- Route 22 will no longer service Montgomery

Route 28 Silverspring

- The transfer point between the 28 Silverspring and the 40 City Centre has been moved to Evergreen Boulevard and Manek Road

Route 40 City Centre

- The transfer point between the 28 Silverspring and the 40 City Centre has been moved to Evergreen Boulevard and Manek Road

Route 60 Confederation

- Frequency: 30 minutes daytime / 60 minutes evenings and weekends
- Scheduled times will change during peak periods Monday to Friday

Route 61 Blairmore – New Route

- Route 61 Blairmore will be replacing the Blairmore portion of the previous Route 23
- Routing and times remain the same except for new travel added to downtown via 22nd Street during peak periods, Monday to Friday

Route 62 Montgomery – New Route

- Route 62 Montgomery will be replacing the Montgomery portion of route 22
- Routing and times remain the same except for new travel added to and from downtown via 22nd Street during peak periods, Monday to Friday

Route 63 Hampton Village – New Route

- Route 63 Hampton Village will be replacing the Hampton Village portion of the previous Route 23
- Routing and times remain the same except for new travel added from downtown via 22nd Street during peak periods, Monday to Friday

Route 65 Kensington

- Frequency: 30 minutes daytime / 60 minutes evenings and weekends
- Scheduled times will change during peak periods Monday to Friday
